

DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Town of Queensbury in the vicinity of the Clendon Brook Road Culvert on Clendon Brook Road approximately 1,000' west of the Clendon Brook and West Mountain Road intersection on Monday, July 3, 2017.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to the washout and destruction of a portion of Clendon Brook Road.


This situation threatens the public safety.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent Order.

As the Town Supervisor of the Town of Queensbury, I, John F. Strough, exercise the authority given me under New York State Executive Law Section 24, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, wellbeing and health of Town of Queensbury and area residents.

I hereby direct all Departments of the Town of Queensbury to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.
