Dear Resident/Landowner

The Town of Queensbury Highway Department is pleased to announce our annual fall yard waste **RESIDENTIAL** pick-up. We would like to thank all of you for your cooperation during spring pick-up and would like to take this opportunity to thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation during this event.

As with our previous pick-ups, it is imperative that we adhere 100% to our scheduling. Please make note of the dates when we will be in your ward, the date on which you should have your items at the road side, and special attention to the **do** and **do not** that pertain to this particular pick-up.

As always, **yard waste must be put into biodegradable paper bags**. This allows us to dispose of the waste in a way that is not harmful to the environment. It is imperative that **only yard waste** is placed in bags. Bags filled with items other than those stated and **weighing more than 50 pounds** will **NOT** be accepted.

2017 SCHEDULED PICK-UP DATES

October 23th – 27th

*Bags must be out by **Oct 22nd**

WARD THREE

October 30th – November 3rd

*Bags must be out by **Oct 29th**

WARD FOUR

November 6th – 9th

*Bags must be out by **Nov 5th**

WARDS ONE & TWO

THESE DATES MUST BE ADHERED TO 100% AS OUR SCHEDULING DOES NOT ALLOW US TO BACKTRACK TO ANY LOCATION.

PLEASE RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

DO

DO bag leaves, grass clippings and pine needles in biodegradable paper bags. Leave bags close to roadside, but **not in the street.**

DO place materials at the roadside on the weekend **before** the scheduled pick up.

DO contact the Highway Department at 761-8211 between 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. if you have any questions.

DO NOT

DO NOT mix topsoil, sod, trash, rocks, or heavy materials in with the leaves, grass and pine needles. If bags are over 50 lbs., they will not get picked up.

DO NOT use any bags other than the biodegradable paper bags. Any others will **NOT** be picked up. (e.g. plastic)

DO NOT place bags out in the elements any earlier than 1 week before scheduled pick-up, as they will possibly disintegrate and will not be picked up.

DO NOT place any yard waste generated by a commercial venture (e.g. landscaper, lawn care, etc.) at the roadside.

DO NOT PLACE ANIMAL WASTE IN BAGS.
