Chapter 140-6(5) Off-premises directional sign [from Town Code]

- a) Signs for the convenience of the general public and for the purpose of directing persons to a business, activity, service or community facility may be erected in any zone, provided that such signs do not exceed 10 sq. ft. of area per establishment, not to exceed a total of 100 sq. ft.
- b) Text shall be limited to name or identification; arrow or direction; and distance. Advertising messages shall be prohibited.
- c) Permits for such signs shall be subject to the approval of the TOQ Planning Board.
- d) Such signs shall be limited to major and collector streets [see 179-19-020].
