Welcome DBA Members:

Family duties have called me out of town so that I am not able to join you for our second Annual Meeting. I am helping my daughter move to California including assisting her in driving her car to California filled with her belongings. Since it is her time to drive, I have some time to write to you.

We have had a very productive first year and we are making progress on completing the tasks with which we have been charged. We have had about 18 systems inspected and another 4 are scheduled for inspections. We are also offering landowners the option of having some of the cost of a septic tank pump-out paid for if during the pump-out the hauler completes an inspection sheet.

Most importantly for the health of the Bay, 10 property owners have installed new systems to replace current old systems. These systems will have a direct positive impact on the issues facing our Bay. Many of the systems are enhanced treatment systems that will greatly reduce the discharge of harmful effluents into the Bay. A matching grant program from the Fund for Lake George is providing funding for half the cost of installing these systems. For that we are very appreciative and hope that when you have the chance you will let the Fund know that we are.

Our main goal for this year is to complete the site visit and mapping program and also to educate all of the property owners about the options available to them to protect the Bay through modernization of existing septic systems, as needed.
