

# Town of Queensbury Residential Lawn & Yard Annual Fall Leaf Pick-Up

*Limited to leaves, grass clippings, & pine needles*

**NO BRUSH IN FALL PICK UP**

## DO...

- ...Bag leaves, grass clippings, and pine needles in biodegradable paper bags and leave close to roadside, but **not in the street.**
- ...Place materials at the roadside the weekend **before** the scheduled pick-up.
- ...Contact the Highway Department at 518-761-8211 between 7:00am-3:00pm if you have any questions.

## DO NOT...

- ...Mix topsoil, sod, trash, rocks, stones or heavy materials in with the leaves, grass & pine needles. Bags over 50 lbs will not be picked up.
- ...Use any bags other than the biodegradable bags. Any others will **not** be picked up (i.e. plastic).
- ...Place bags out in the elements any earlier than 2 weeks before scheduled pickup, as they will possibly disintegrate & will not be picked up.
- ...Place any yard waste generated by a commercial venture (i.e. landscaper, lawn care, etc.) at the roadside.
- ...Do not place animal waste in bags**

## Scheduled pick-up dates:

Ward 3	Nov. 5th-16th *** yard waste must be <b>out by Nov. 4th</b>
Ward 4	Nov. 19th-23rd *** yard waste must be <b>out by Nov. 18th</b>
Wards 1 & 2	Nov. 26th-30th *** yard waste must be <b>out by Nov. 25th</b>

**These dates must be adhered to 100% as our scheduling does not allow us to backtrack to any location.**
