Dear Resident/Landowner,

The Town of Queensbury Highway Department is pleased to announce our annual spring yard **RESIDENTIAL** pick-up. We would like to thank all of you for your cooperation during last year's pick-up and take this opportunity to thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation during this year's event.

It is imperative that we adhere to our scheduling. Please make note of the dates we will be in your ward, the date which you should have your items at the road side and give special attention to the dos and don'ts that pertain to this particular pick-up.

As in previous years, yard pick-up must be put into *biodegradable paper bags*. This allows us to properly dispose of yard pick-up that is not harmful to the environment. It is imperative that only yard pick-up is placed into bags. Bags filled with items other than those stated will **NOT** be accepted. Bags put out too early will disintegrate from the rain and weather.

**Brush pick up means branches that fell down during the winter from snow, ice and wind. This residential yard pickup is not meant to clear cut lots, cut down trees or shrubs, etc. Please adhere to these rules.**

### TOWN OF QUEENSBURY RESIDENTIAL LAWN & YARD SPRING PICKUP

**\*\* During spring pick-up, we will take LEAVES, GRASS CLIPPINGS, and PINE NEEDLES in paper biodegradable bags. We will also take brush and branches which fell during winter.**

**This residential yard pick-up is not meant to clear cut lots, cut down trees or shrubs, etc.**

| DO...  | PLEASE DO NOT...  |

| DO bag leaves, grass clippings, & pine needles in biodegradable paper bags. Leave bags close to roadside, but <b>Not in the Street</b> . | DO NOT mix topsoil, sod, trash, rocks, stones, or heavy materials in with the leaves, grass & pine needles. Bags over 50 lbs will not be picked up. |
| DO Place tree limbs, which are not to exceed 4 inches in diameter or 8 foot in length.   | DO NOT use bags other than biodegradable paper bags. Any others will <b>NOT</b> be picked up. (e.g., plastic)                                       |
| DO Place materials at the roadside the day that is schedule <u>before</u> the pickup, but <b>Not in the Street</b> .                     | DO NOT place yard waste generated by a commercial venture, e.g., landscaper, lawn care, etc., at the roadside.                                      |
| DO contact the Highway department at <b>518-761-8211</b> between 7:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. if you have any questions.                        | DO NOT place animal waste in bags.  |

### SCHEDULED PICK-UP DATES FOR 2020

**WARD THREE (3) \*YARD PICK-UP MUST BE OUT ON ROAD SIDE BY APRIL 19<sup>TH</sup>**

**WARD FOUR (4) \*YARD PICK-UP MUST BE OUT ON ROAD SIDE BY MAY 3<sup>RD</sup>**

**WARD TWO (2) \*YARD PICK-UP MUST BE OUT ON ROAD SIDE BY MAY 10<sup>TH</sup>**

**WARD ONE (1) \*YARD PICK-UP MUST BE OUT ON ROAD SIDE BY MAY 17<sup>TH</sup>**

**THESE DATES MUST BE ADHERED TO 100% AS OUR SCHEDULING DOES NOT ALLOW US TO BACKTRACK TO ANY LOCATION.**
