

# Town of Queensbury Residential Lawn & Yard Annual Spring Pick-Up

***Limited to leaves, grass clippings and branches only***

## **DO...**

- ...Bag leaves, grass clippings, and pine needles in biodegradable paper bags and leave close to roadside, but **not in the street.**
- ...Place tree limbs, which are not to exceed **8 feet in length** or **4 inches in diameter** at the roadside, **not in the street.**
- ...Place materials at the roadside the weekend before the scheduled pick-up.
- ...Contact the Highway Department at (518) 761-8211 and leave a message in the bag & brush line 1.

## **DO NOT...**

- ...Mix topsoil, sod, trash, rocks, sand, stones or heavy materials in with the leaves, grass & pine needles. **Bags over 50 lbs will not be picked up.**
- ...Use any bags other than the biodegradable bags. Any others will **NOT** be picked up (i.e. plastic).
- ...Place any limb larger than 4 inches in diameter at the roadside for pick-up.
- ...Place any yard waste generated by a commercial venture (e.g. landscaper, lawn care, etc.) at the roadside.
- ...**place animal waste in bags or cut down trees or shrubs**

## **Please note:**

Biodegradable bags may be purchased at your local hardware, home improvement or grocery store.

***Please retain for future reference***

## **Scheduled pick-up dates:**

- Ward 3: yard waste must be **out on April 19th**
  - Ward 4: yard waste must be **out on May 3rd**
  - Ward 2: yard waste must be **out on May 10th**
  - Ward 1: yard waste must be **out on May 17th**
- X These dates must be adhered to 100% as our scheduling does not allow us to backtrack to any location.**
