

Town of Queensbury - 2023 Annual Residential Spring Pick-Up

Pick-up is limited to leaves and branches

BRANCHES

- Only fallen branches from winter storm damage – not from pruning and clearing.
- **One pile of branches per home** – no larger than 4' high, 4' wide, and 6' long.
- All limbs must have a diameter of 4" or less.
- No stumps, shrubs, or root balls.
- All branch piles must be close to the road, but not in the road.

LEAF BAGS

- All leaves and pine needles must be bagged.
- Bags over 50 pounds will be not be picked up.
- Biodegradable paper bags must be used.
- No topsoil, sod, trash, stones, sand, or animal waste.
- Absolutely no waste generated by a commercial venture (landscaper) will be accepted.

Scheduled pick-up dates:

Ward 4: leaf bags and branches must be out by May 7th

Ward 2: leaf bags and branches must be out by May 14th

Ward 3: leaf bags and branches must be out by May 21st

Ward 1: leaf bags and branches must be out by June 4th

The Town of Queensbury Highway Department is pleased to announce our annual spring yard **RESIDENTIAL** pick-up. We would like to thank all of you for your cooperation during last year's pick-up and take this opportunity to thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation during this year's event.

As in previous years, leaves, grass and pine needles must be put into **biodegradable paper bags**. This allows us to properly dispose of them in a manner that is not harmful to the environment. It is imperative that only leaves, grass and pine needles are placed into bags. Bags filled with items other than those stated will **NOT** be accepted. Bags put out too early will disintegrate from the rain and weather.

We only remove branches that fell down during the winter from snow, ice, and wind. This residential yard pick-up is not meant to clear-cut lots, cut down trees or shrubs, or prune trees, etc. Please adhere to these rules.

Each home is **permitted one pile of branches**. The pile must not be larger than 4' high, 4' wide and 6' feet long. All limbs must be 4" in diameter or less. Absolutely no stumps, shrubs or root balls.
