TOWN OF QUEENSBURY ANNUAL RESIDENTIAL FALL LEAF BAG PICK-UP

Dear Resident/Landowner

The Queensbury Highway Department is pleased to announce our annual **RESIDENTIAL** fall leaf bag pick-up. We would like to thank all of you for anticipated cooperation during this event.

As with our previous pick-ups, it is imperative that we adhere 100% to our scheduling. Please make note of the dates when we will be in your ward, the date on which you should have your items at the roadside, and special attention to the **DOs** and **DO NOTs** that pertain to this particular pick-up.

As always, **leaves, pine needles, and grass clipping must be placed in biodegradable paper bags.** This allows us to dispose of them in a way that is not harmful to the environment. It is imperative that **only leaves, pine needles and grass clippings** are in the bags. Bags filled with items other than those stated and **weighing more than 50 pounds** will **NOT** be accepted.

2023 FALL SCHEDULED PICK-UP DATES

WARDS 1 & 2

*Bags must be out by **Nov. 5th, 2023** (*Will be picked-up within the week.*)

WARD 4

*Bags must be out by **Nov. 12th, 2023** (*Will be picked-up within the week.*)

WARD 3

*Bags must be out by **Nov. 19th, 2023** (*Will be picked-up within two weeks.*)

THESE DATES MUST BE ADHERED TO 100% AS OUR SCHEDULING DOES NOT ALLOW US TO BACKTRACK TO ANY LOCATION.

DO

DO bag leaves, pine needles and grass clippings in biodegradable paper bags.

Leave bags close to the roadside, but **not in the street.**

DO place materials at the roadside on the weekend **before** the scheduled pick up.

DO NOT

DO NOT mix topsoil, sod, trash, rocks or heavy materials in with the leaves, grass and pine needles. If bags are over 50 lbs., they will not get picked up.

DO NOT use any bags other than the biodegradable paper bags. Any others will **NOT** be picked up. (e.g. plastic)

DO NOT place bags out in the elements any earlier than 1 week before scheduled pick-up, as they will possibly disintegrate and will not be picked up.

DO NOT place any yard waste generated by a commercial venture (e.g. landscaper, lawn care, etc.) at the roadside.

DO NOT PLACE ANIMAL WASTE IN BAGS.
