 - -Clarification of language regarding an ETU inspection so that it satisfies Town requirements and allows the inspecting engineer to certify that the system is functioning properly
 - -Specifying the amount of time the home owner has to update or replace a failed septic system. Our legislation states "a reasonable amount of time".

Town wording for a Transfer law situation states "six months".
