## DOG LICENSING INFORMATION

All dog licenses in the Town of Queensbury are renewable one year from registration.

To obtain a dog license by mail, complete the Dog License Application and enclose the following:

- A copy of the current rabies certificate,
- Proof of spay/neuter
- Your check (make payable to: Town of Queensbury)
- If senior citizen (65 years & older), enclose copy of proper identification (to receive discount)

Dog licenses can also be obtained at the Town Office Building (742 Bay Road, Queensbury, NY 12804) Monday through Friday between 8:00am and 4:00pm.

Dogs over four months of age must be licensed. If you are new to the area or have recently acquired a dog, you have thirty days to license your dog.

It is the responsibility of the owner to report any dog status changes (i.e., death, lost or stolen, change of address)
